Health Care and Worker's Compensation Discounts

Blue Cross/Blue Shield: Chamber members with two or more full time employees are eligible for discounted healthcare rates. Most members who participate in this program state that the money they save in the yearly premiums exceeds their annual membership investment amount.

Drugs Don't Work: Chamber members receive 7.5 percent discount off their Worker's Compensation premiums when they become a Certified Drug Free Workplace.

Publicity and Exposure

All Chamber members receive the Chamber's weekly publication "Just the Fax" which gives updates on events, awards and new members. Chamber members can also submit their own "news" for inclusions in this publication.

Referral Systems

The Chamber receives hundreds of request each year for recommendations on goods and services to be purchased in the Telfair County Area (Helena, Jacksonville, Lumber City, McRae, Milan and Scotland). We highlight our Chamber Members to those newcomers, visitors, new industry and area residents. Additional referrals are made through email inquiries.

Telfair Shop At Home

This program promotes "Shop At Home" events and activities. The Chamber issues "Shop at Home Gift Checks" throughout the year that can be used at participating **businesses that are Chamber Members.**
