#### 3. Booth Fees:

There are 12 (10' x 10') spaces available with electricity (two 110 plug-ins) and 70+ (10' x 10') spaces available without electricity. *These will be filled on a first received-first accepted basis. It is recommended you get your application in asap to ensure your spot.* 

Booth Space with electricity: 1 day (\$35) 2 days (\$60 - save \$10) Booth Space without electricity: 1 day (\$25) 2 days (\$40 - save \$10) **There will be NO CHARGE for early setup on Friday afternoon.** (See set up times on page 1)

**There will be security guards posted in the vendor and rides area Friday and Saturday nights.** (You will still be responsible for securing your booth - Little Ocmulgee State Park or Friends of Little Ocmulgee State Park will not be held responsible for your items).

\*It will be at your discretion if you choose to stay open during the Saturday evening concert from 7-10 pm. (*Or you can relax and enjoy the free concert*!). Concert goers will be passing through the vendor area to get to the Amphitheater.

#### **Guidelines and Rules**

-Vendors cannot park campers or vehicles in the Festival area during the hours of operation.

-Each vendor will be held responsible for the safety of their own booth and materials. Each vendor will be responsible for maintaining a **safe and clean area** in and around their vending area. Your area must be clean and free of litter when you leave.

-All vendors must provide their own display (table, chairs, tents, etc.), electrical cord, water hoses. Please use heavy duty electrical cords.

#### For your Information

-There are public bathroom facilities available in the vendor area.

-If you need lodging, Little Ocmulgee State Park and Lodge will be honored to accommodate your needs. The Lodge offers hotel-style guest rooms and a restaurant with a golf course view. There are 10 lakeside cabins, 60 lodge rooms, and 55 tent, trailer, and RV campsites with cable TV hookups. Call 229-868-7474 for reservations. It is recommended you make your reservations early.

-We are home to the 18-hole Wallace Adams Golf Course which was selected as the "Readers Choice" golf course in Georgia Magazine. For your pleasure there is also miniature golf, volleyball, bike rentals, a 2.6-mile hiking trail with a vulture roost and boardwalk, and a children's playground. Pets are allowed but must be on a 6 foot leash.
